Call for Expression of Interest

The South African-German Energy Programme (SAGEN), funded by the German government and implemented by Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) in cooperation with the Department of Energy (DoE) is collaborating with the South African Local Government Association (SALGA) and frontrunner municipalities to establish adequate framework conditions for renewable Small Scale Embedded Generation (SSEG).

The City of Tshwane (CoT) has recently embarked on a city-wide SSEG programme that allows electricity customers to connect rooftop PV systems to the City's electricity distribution grid. Under this programme, the CoT staff will be trained and exposed to solar PV systems.

The South African-German Energy Programme (SAGEN) seeks for a service provider to deliver on the following:

1. Provide technical support to develop a 2-day training short course dedicated to CoT technical staff
2. Provide technical support to pilot the 2-day training short course in the CoT
3. Supply and install three demonstration solar PV systems "residential size" which will be used during the training of CoT technical staff
